

## SCHOOL RULES

All students are expected to follow school rules. Showing respect for people and property allows everyone the opportunity to learn in a safe, pleasant environment. Teachers and staff model socially acceptable behaviors and instruct students to follow the school rules which include:

1. Follow directions respectfully and quickly the first time they are given by a school adult or student monitor.
2. Keep hands, feet, mouth, and objects to yourself.
3. Put people "up" not "down."
4. Always be in the proper place at the proper time.
5. Always walk and use quiet voices in the building.
6. Use all materials, equipment and facilities properly.

If an administrative intervention is needed, parents may be notified.
